The Iowa Department of Human Rights, Division of Community Action Agencies has announced the publication FFY 2019 Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) State Plan. Copies of the plan are available for public viewing at all Iowa Community Action Agencies, Iowa Department of Human Services' offices, and Iowa Area Agencies on Aging, until August 7, 2018. The Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program has been established to help qualifying low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay a portion of their primary heating costs.

The plan is subject to change based on comments received by the state and regulations from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services.
